


## **Assembly Instructions**

Elevate Admin Table Electric

Before you begin, please make sure all parts and proper quantities are included. (See Part Identifier Key) Any parts damaged during shipment must be reported within 24 hours of receipt. To report information regarding damages or if you have any questions, please call 800.242.2303.


#### Step 1:

- Place both 1200-1800 tube frames on the top. Align with the pre-drilled holes in the top.
- Install (24) 5mmx25mm button-head screws using a Phillips bit and screw gun.




### Step 2:

• Place adjustment-u-channel and top supports on the top as shown in the image below, align with the pre-drilled holes in the top. Install (16) 5mmx25mm button-head screws using a Phillips bit and screw gun.



### Step 3:

• Locate Column LifeUp Pro TM Q70/3. Insert into tube frame & adjustment-u-channel as shown below. Apply pressure until column is snug and secure.



### **Tools Required**

- · Phillips screwdriver OR
- Phillips bit
- Srew gun
- 12mm Allen wrench



### Step 4:

- Place one foot on top of the column aligning the holes.
- Using a 12mm Allen wrench, fasten foot to column with (4) M8x16 Cylinder screws.
- Repeat Step 4 for other foot.




# Step 5: • Twist each leveler into the hole of the feet until tight.

### Step 6:

• Place 240W power supply on the table top as shown in the image to the right. Align with the pre-drilled holes. Attach using (2) 5mm x 25mm button-head screws and a #2 Phillips screwdriver.


### Step 7:

• Place hand switch on the table top as shown in the image to the right. Align with the pre-drilled holes. Attach using (2) 4mm x 16mm button-head screws and a #2 Phillips screwdriver.



### Step 8:

• Plug power cord and handset in to the power supply as shown in the image to the right.







### Step 9:

- Thread power cord through cord mouting clamps.
- Align the holes on the clamps with the pre-drilled holes on the table top. Attach with screws (NOT PROVIDED).
